the Savior of all, lying in a manger.**

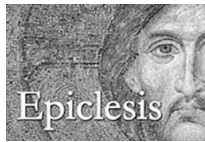
On this holy Eve

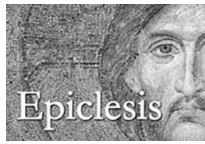
## SECOND LESSON Matthew 1:18-23

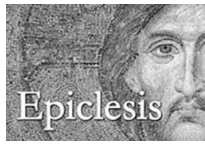
### THE LORD'S TABLE
